2026 2027 2028	This is our first plan, and it is important as it will help us know what to do for the next five years.










#### Our plan will

Our weather and the nature around us are so important that the laws that started SOSE make sure that we think about both the climate and nature in everything that we do.








- We are facing a weather and nature crisis that is shaping our places and people.

We know new and growing business can make fair and enjoyable work.


They can help us to keep the staff that already work in the South of Scotland and get new ones.

We want to celebrate and show people all about the business talent we have across the region.










We know that in the South of Scotland we have fewer new startup businesses than the rest of Scotland








3. We will work together to help shape and put forward a range of support around making things.


5. We will make a system for ideas to grow in the South of Scotland.
