Thank you for your Freedom of Information request of 20 November 2025. We are responding to you under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 [FOISA].

## **FOI REQUEST (20 November 2025)**

Please provide the following information for the last five financial years, or the most recent period for which data is available:

1. The total amount of funding provided to female founders, broken down by:
  - Micro loans
  - Start-up loans
  - Growth or development loans
  - Any other relevant loan categories used by your organisation
2. The total amount of funding provided to male founders, broken down using the same loan categories as above.
3. The number of recipients (male and female) within each loan category listed above.
4. The ratio of funding awarded to female founders compared with male founders, presented annually for the period requested.
5. If available, please also provide:
  - (a) Any internal assessments, reports or analysis relating to gender disparities in business lending or support.
  - (b) Any policies or initiatives specifically aimed at supporting female founders.

## **CLARIFICATION RECEIVED (28 November 2025)**

In absence of data held for female founders, please proceed with the definition as suggested.

Definition - 'female led' organisations which is defined as 'the organisation is female owned or is owned by a partnership of people including a woman, or over 50% of owners or board members are female'.

Please note the following –

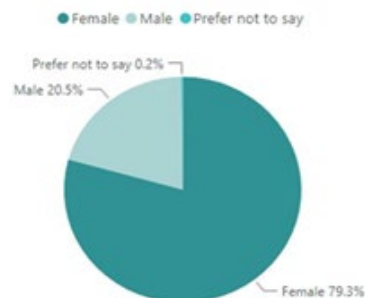
- Female led organisation - if owned by a female or owned by a partnership of people including a female, or over 50% of owners or board members are female.
